OFFICE ORDER

The Maharashtra Fire Prevention and Life Safety Measures Act, 2006 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Fire Act') and The Maharashtra Fire Prevention and Life Safety Measures Rules, 2009 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Fire Rules') which has come in force in the areas of Local Authorities and Planning Authorities w.e.f. 6th December, 2008 and 23rd June,2009 respectively.
